Scope of Work _____

Times of Operation in Incline Village/Crystal Bay _____

Following the adopted Fire Code, a permit is required for mobile food preparation vehicles equipped with appliances that produce smoke or grease laden vapors. If applicable, please acknowledge the following requirements:

Adopted Fire Code, Nevada State Fire Marshal, and NFPA requirements.	Initial
A permit is required from NLTFPD <i>prior</i> to operating in Incline Village/Crystal Bay. The permit can only be issued after a site inspection with the Fire Inspector.	
A 2.5-gallon Class K extinguisher will need to be provided or two 1.5-gallon Class K extinguishers (Section 906.4). Extinguishers shall be placed in a conspicuous location, unobstructed, and securely anchored (Section 906.4). Extinguisher shall be currently serviced by contractor with State Fire Marshal.	
Cooking equipment that produces grease laden vapors shall be provided with a kitchen exhaust hood, in accordance with Section 607 (Section 319). Kitchen hoods shall be cleaned in accordance with Section 603.3.	
Cooking equipment producing grease laden vapors shall be protected by an automatic fire extinguishing system, following Section 906.4 (Section 319), following applicable NFPA standards. The system shall be currently serviced by a licensed contractor with the State Fire Marshal.	
Gas cooking appliances shall be secured in place and connected to fuel-supply piping with an appliance connector complying with ANSI Z21.69/CSA 6.16 . The connector shall be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. Appliances shall be limited by movement using restraining devices installed in accordance with the connector's and appliance's manufacturer's specifications (Section 319).	
LP-gas containers installed on the vehicle and fuel-gas piping shall be inspected annually by an approved inspection agency or a company that is registered with the USDOT to requalify LP-gas cylinders (Section 319).	
Metallic storage tanks for oil within mobile food trucks shall be listed under UL 80 or UL 142 and installed in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.	
Non-metallic storage tanks for oil shall be listed for use, including during maximum temperatures of use, and not exceeding 200 gallons.	
Normal and emergency venting shall be provided for cooking oil storage tanks (Section 319).	
LP-gas containers shall (Section 319): (a) not exceed 200 lbs.; (b) be securely mounted and restrained to prevent movement; (c) have piping, including valves and fittings, that is adequately protected from tampering and damage; (d) have an LP-gas alarm system installed according to manufacturer's specifications.
