

Form: Recreational Burn Permit 2018-3

Inspection Description:

This is a North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District (NLTFPD) permit to have a recreational fire. This permit, once issued, must be available on site for inspection. Requirements specified in this permit shall be followed, as required following the adopted Fire Code, Wildland-Urban Interface Code, and requirements set by NLTFPD. Permit issuance is valid only for the designated address on this permit. Recreational fires are prohibited on Red Flag Days. Please visit NLTFPD.ORG to determine fire weather and current burn day status. Recreational fires must be constantly attended by an adult. All fires shall be extinguished by 9pm or once unattended. Short Term Rentals are not permitted to have recreational fires.

Inspection Topics:

Recreational Fire Requirements

Recreational fires must be contained within a non-combustible container and covered with a 1/8" mesh. Recreational fires cannot be located on or under balconies, decks, patio covers or within 30' of any structure/combustibles, including vegetation and pine needles. Only clean wood may be burned. No debris or hazardous materials may be burned. A secondary water source with a charged nozzle or a 4A extinguisher must be within reach.

By signing this permit, I understand and agree to comply with the requirements of this permit. I certify that I have read the above requirements and recognize that I will be responsible for all costs (suppression and/or response) which may occur as a result of any negligence related to open burning on my property (NRS 475.230). Any failure to follow the requirements of this permit may also result in revocation of this Seasonal Open Burn Permit by NLTFPD. Every person who willfully or negligently sets or fails to guard carefully or extinguish any fire, whether on the person's own land or the land of another, whereby the timber or property of another is endangered is guilty of a misdemeanor (NRS 475.010). Every person who, with gross negligence, lights a fire for any purpose along the road through any woodland, or upon the same, or at any other place in the open, and thereby, or by any other means, sets fire to any growing timber or forest, shrubbery, crops, grass or vegetation, and thereby causes the destruction of any timber, forest, crops, grass, vegetation or property not his or her own, is guilty of a public offense, as prescribed in NRS 193.155, proportionate to the value of the loss resulting therefrom, in addition to being liable to the owner of such property for the full value thereof in a civil action (NRS 475.040). Each fire department may investigate: the cause, origin and circumstances of each fire which occurs within its jurisdiction and which results in the destruction of or damage to property, loss of life, or injury to any person; any report received pursuant to NRS 629.045 to determine the origin of the fire which caused the injury (NRS 475.125). It is unlawful for any person willfully or negligently: to throw or place any lighted cigarette, cigar, ashes, match or other material which may cause a fire in any place where such lighted cigarette, cigar, match, ashes or other material may start a fire (NRS 475.030).
