

## Recruitment for Public Information Officer



The North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District (NLTFPD) is seeking a highly motivated and skilled Public Information Officer (PIO) to join our team. This is an exciting opportunity for an individual with exceptional communication skills, a passion for community engagement, and the ability to lead fire and life safety public education initiatives.

Since 1959, NLTFPD has had the honor of protecting life and property in one of the most beautiful places on earth. Additionally, NLTFPD has maintained an active presence and strong reputation amongst our agency partners in the Lake Tahoe Basin and surrounding jurisdictions.

NLTFPD is nestled in the northeastern portion of the Lake Tahoe Basin, on the Nevada side of the Lake serving the communities of Incline Village and Crystal Bay, an area of approximately 16 square miles. The area has a permanent population of approximately 10,000 residents that doubles during peak winter and summer recreational periods.

The Public Information Officer (PIO) is responsible for leading and coordinating community risk reduction initiatives within the North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District (NLTFPD). Reporting directly to the Fire Chief and Fire Marshal, the PIO plays a key role in public engagement, emergency communication, and public education efforts. This position requires adaptability, collaboration, and the ability to manage multiple priorities effectively. The PIO works closely with various NLTFPD divisions, local municipalities, and external agencies to ensure all outreach efforts align with the District's mission of fire safety and community preparedness.

- Familiarity with emergency response protocols and crisis communication strategies.

- Ability to respond promptly and effectively to public and media inquiries during emergencies.
- Knowledge of basic public safety terminology and operations.
